McMillan Launches New Long-Range Rifle



McMillan—long known for its famous Tac-50 rifle, which is used by the military and police—recently introduced a line of long-range hunting rifles chambered in .300, .308 and .338 (pictured).

THIS PAST SUMMER, McMillan announced the expansion of its hunting line with the introduction of the Long Range Hunting Rifle (LRH). The new rifle is specifically designed for precision long-distance shooting.

The LRH rifle is custom-built, with benchrest tolerances, and features

the McMillan G30 custom long- or short-action. The rifle is chambered in .308 Winchester, .300 Winchester Magnum and .338 Lapua Magnum, with stainless-steel match-grade barrels machined to medium-heavy contour.

In addition, the barrel threads and the chamber are cut to critical

tolerances and fit by hand. The barrel axis is perfectly in line with the bolt axis.

The rifle's bolt face and action face are precisely perpendicular to the barrel axis. The action is pillar-bedded into the stock, and the barrel is free-floated. In addition, the barrel is offered at different lengths—24 inches, 26 inches and 27 inches, depending on the caliber.

The ergonomic McMillan A-3 fiberglass stock comes standard and features a fixed cheekpiece and recoil pad. The A-3 stock is specifically designed for long-range shooting.

Other standard features of the rifle include a machined one-piece, steel-hinged floor plate that provides easy unloading and a tuned, 3-pound trigger. Many accessories are available for the LRH rifle, including a scope, cleaning equipment and other options.

McMillan designed the rifle with the notion that long-range hunting is an art—particularly, the art of delivering benchrest accuracy at extreme distances. The company noted that while long-range shooting was once the domain of a few international long-range competitive events, now many big-game hunters are asking for equipment that can deliver accurate performance at extreme distances.

According to company president Kelly McMillan, "The Long Range Hunting Rifle delivers superior performance and reliability, which are both important on a successful long-range hunt."
